

# Comforting Knitted Shawl

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**Skills Required:** Knit, purl, purl 3 together, cast on, bind off, single crochet

**Materials:** 2 balls Red Heart Dreamy Stripes, color Calm Breeze (355 yards), 1 ball Red Heart Dreamy, color Ivory *for border* (466 yards)

**Needles:** Size US 10.5 (6.5mm) and one Size US I/9 (5.5mm) crochet hook

**Gauge:** 3.75 sts = 1 inch in Stockinette or 4 sts = 1 inch in Trinity stitch

**Size:** Approximately 19 inches wide and 60 inches long

**Notes:** All rows begin and end with knit 1 for an even edge stitch. If you want to make your shawl wider than 19 inches simply add stitches in multiples of 4 remembering that the 2 edge sts are **not** part of the stitch pattern count. You add those on last.

## Knitted Shawl Pattern

Cast on 82 stitches with preferred cast on method. I used the long tail.

Knit 3 rows.

Continue in trinity stitch pattern below

Row 1 (right side): Purl

Row 2: Knit 1, \*(K1, p1, k1) in the same stitch, purl 3 together. Repeat from \* across to last stitch, K1

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: Knit 1, \*P3tog, (k1, p1, k1) in the same stitch. Repeat from \* across row to last stitch, K1

Repeat these four rows until you've reached 60 inches or desired length.

Next Row: Purl

Then finish with knit 3 rows.

Bind off loosley.

Finishing

Weave in ends and finish with single crochet border.
