

Garter Stitch Hat - Easiest Ever Hat Pattern



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This is an incredibly easy hat knitting pattern. In fact it is so fast and easy that you'll want to make more than one. So gather up some knitting yarn and get started.

You'll want to make one for all your family and friends.

This hat can be a cute slouchy hat or you can have it fit your head snugly by folding up the brim some more.

Skills Required: Garter stitch

Finished Circumference: Approx 19 – 20 inches

Materials:

1 Skein worsted weight yarn
Knitting needles: US 9 (5.5 mm)
Tapestry needle

Gauge: Not important (It's so fun when you see this right? Ha)

Pattern Notes:

Gauge is not important for this knitting project. Garter stitch stretches a lot so this hat will fit a lot of sizes.

Just an idea: If you have some leftover yarn, have some more fun knitting and make up some fingerless mittens too. Then you'll have a nice set.

Instructions

Cast on 76 stitches

Knit garter stitch for approximately 12 inches.

Bind off leaving a long tail. (The long yarn tail is for closing the top of the hat).

Sewing up:

Thread tapestry needle and beginning at brim, sew up side seam creating a tube. Then with tapestry needle weave in and out of bound-off stitches pulling tightly to close the hole. Weave in ends securely.
