

HOODED COWL KNITTING PATTERN

Skills Required

Circular knitting
Knit Stitch
Cast on
Bind off

Materials:

Yarn: 1 Skein worsted weight (medium) yarn

Circular needles: Length = 16 inches, Size US 8 (5.00 mm)

Gauge: 4.5 sts and 6 row = 1 inch

NOTES

Here's a little knitting tip and what I like to do before joining my work in the round. As you may know it's really important to make sure that none of the stitches are twisted around the needle. If they are you will have to rip your knitting out. And I've done it. So I like to knit flat for a couple of rows before I join my work. That way it's easier to see if my work is twisted or not.

When I knitted this hooded cowl I knit 4 rows of Garter stitch flat. You could of course knit Stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row) if you wish. It doesn't matter. Then I joined my work.

Cast on 92 stitches and don't join.

Knit 4 rows Garter stitch

When you finish the 4 rows straighten out your knitting, make sure your stitches aren't twisted around the needle. Join work and place a marker at the beginning of your work so that you know where your round begins.

Knit around and around for at least 20 inches. End by knitting 4 rows of Garter stitch.

Finish

Bind off very loosely, seam the couple of rows of garter stitch that you knit before joining your work and weave in the ends.
