

KEYHOLE SCARF PATTERN

Skills Required:

Garter stitch
Joining yarn
Placing stitches on stitch holder

Finished size: Width 7" (18 cm) – Length 45" (114 cm)

Materials:

2 skeins (see pattern notes) Patons Canadian 100% acrylic – 200 yds/182 meters, net weight 3 ½ oz. / 100g – color purple or any color you like
Needles: 9 US / 5.5 mm for using 2 strands held together or US 8 (5 mm) for using 1 strand of yarn
2 small stitch holders
Tapestry Needle

Patterns Notes:

This keyhole scarf only uses 1 skein of yarn however I used 2 skeins and held two strands together as one so that it was thicker and warmer

Gauge: Not important

Instructions: Cast on 24 sts.

Knit garter stitch for 8 inches

Divide stitches for keyhole:

Knit 12 sts and place remaining stitches (12) on holder.

Turn work and continue knitting on 12 stitches for 4 inches. Cut yarn and place these stitches on second stitch holder.

Slip stitches from first holder back to needle and join yarn. Knit for 4 inches, same as for first slit, making sure that the garter stitch ridges match up evenly on both sides. (This completes the keyhole).

Bringing all stitches together

Knit across 12 sts on needle. Slip the 12 sts from holder onto left needle (making sure they aren't twisted) and continue knitting across row. **All stitches are together again.**

Continue knitting until scarf measures 45 inches or as long as you like.

Bind off loosely. Weave in yarn ends. **Note:** When you weave in ends at keyhole make sure they're nice and secure.
