

NEW KNITTERS NECK WARMER PATTERN

Skills Required: Garter stitch

Measurements: Circumference: Approximately 18 inches without being stretched.
Depth: Approximately 10 inches.

Materials:

Yarn: 1 skein of Bernat Roving - 100 g / 3.5 oz -- 120 yds / 109 m, color Plum or whatever color you like.

Needles: US 10.5 (6.5 mm)

Tapestry Needle

Gauge: 12 sts and 16 rows = 4 inches

Pattern Notes:

You may find it easier to seam up the neck warmer with a different yarn. Roving yarn doesn't seam up very well and tends to fall apart. Try a worsted weight yarn that closely matches the yarn color you used.

Of course if you want to try using the roving yarn do give it a try. I did use it for mine however it did come apart at times.

Neck Warmer Pattern Instructions

Cast on 30 stitches.

Work garter stitch for approximately 106 rows (53 ridges of garter stitch).

Bind off loosely

Finish:

Sew up seam and enjoy. (See pattern notes about seaming).
